**REGISTRATION**

Initial course credit will not be granted through summer school. All courses are CREDIT RECOVERY. Students will register for summer school online via FACTS. Registration runs from May 15-June 12. Each full credit will cost \$550.00 and each half credit will cost \$275.00 and payment is due at the time of online registration. Partial payments will not be accepted. Credit card payments will be accepted online. Payments in Cash or Money Order (made payable to Cobb County School District) will be accepted at walk in Registration on June 12<sup>th</sup> at Sprayberry High School. All refunds must be requested on the official Summer School Refund Request Form (found online) and submitted by June 20<sup>th</sup> to the Cobb County School District office located at 514 Glover Street. No refunds will be made after June 20<sup>nd</sup> for any reason.

**ATTENDANCE**

Classes will be taken via an online program called GradPoint. Students will need to complete a combination of virtual and traditional hours during the program as indicated below. Once the course is complete, the grade will be posted to the transcript IF the student has earned a passing grade. If a passing grade is not reached at the end of the summer school program, the credit will not be awarded and a refund will not be issued. Students MUST be present on July 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> for EOC if the exam is required for the class taken during summer school. Students will be able to choose the sessions/hours from the offered sessions to allow greater flexibility for students needing to participate in other life activities during the summer. If a student is more than 15 minutes late to a session, an entire hour will need to be made up in a different session. Students must attend a minimum of two sessions per day for a full credit and one session per day for a half credit, unless prior approval is obtained from the Principal. A certified teacher in every field of study will be assigned to every student. The teachers will function as “coaches” to motivate and academically support students to assist in a successful completion of the program.

- Minimum 20 sessions attended

Per HALF CREDIT RECOVERY

- Minimum 10 sessions attended

**BEHAVIOR/DRESS CODE**

If a student is suspended from summer school, no tuition will be refunded and the student will not be permitted to make up sessions.
