



## Magnet Testing Updates for 2018-19

Magnet School testing procedures for eighth grade students not currently attending a school in the Cobb County School District (CCSD) are changing this year in an effort to help improve the process. The Cobb County Advanced Learning Office has partnered with Applerouth Tutoring Services who will now handle the Magnet School admissions test administration. This new partnership was forged in an effort to provide students with more testing dates and to improve the feedback students receive about their scores.

This test is similar to the PSAT and is an important component of a complete magnet application.

**The examination will cost \$5 and will be administered on the following dates at the times indicated in the chart. It will be the student's responsibility to register to take the test.**

### Examination Guidance:

- The examination may only be taken once and will cost \$5 per student
- The examination will be administered only on the dates and times indicated in the chart above.
- Seating is limited for each testing session and the seats are filled on a first-come, first-served basis and each student may only take the test one time.
- Testing will begin promptly at the start times indicated and no one will be allowed to enter after the test has started.
- Cell phones are strictly prohibited in the testing room.
- On the day of the test, bring two sharpened pencils with erasers, a watch, and a calculator. Approved calculators include four-function calculators, scientific calculators, and graphing calculators. (Calculators not permitted include: pocket organizer, calculators with QWERTY keypads, calculators with paper tape, calculators that make noises, or calculators that require an outlet. Students will not be allowed to share calculators)

Extended Time Accommodation:

If a student qualifies for an extended-time accommodation for testing (50% additional time only), please have your counselor mail the official accommodation form to Jennifer Tongel at [jtongel@applerouth.com](mailto:jtongel@applerouth.com). Documentation prior to the test will be required.

Results:

The results of the test will be sent to the student and the magnet programs. They will not be placed in a student's permanent academic profile.
