Thank you for your interest in applying to one or more of the Cobb County magnet programs. **Non-CCSD students (private school, homeschool, out of district) must register to take the magnet admissions examination.** The examination will cost \$5 and is being administered by Applerouth Tutoring Services on the following dates:

To register, go to www.applerouth.com/signup and enter the event code.

It will be the student's responsibility to register to take the test. **Seating is limited for each testing session and the seats are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.** This test is similar to the PSAT and is an important component of a complete magnet application. The results of the test will be sent to the student and the magnet programs but will not be placed in a student's permanent academic profile. If you have a question about taking the test, please contact one of the magnet coordinators.

If a student qualifies for an extended-time accommodation for testing (50% additional time only), please have your counselor mail the official accommodation form to Jennifer Tongel at jtongel@applerouth.com. Documentation prior to the test will be required.

On the day of the test, **bring two sharpened pencils with erasers, a watch, and a calculator.** Approved calculators include **four-function calculator, scientific calculator, and graphing calculator.** Calculators **NOT** permitted include: pocket organizer, hand-held or laptop computer, electronic writing pad or pen input device, calculator with a QWERTY (typewriter-like) keypad, calculator with paper tape, calculator that makes noises or "talks", and calculator that requires an outlet. Students will not be allowed to share calculators with other students. Students are not permitted to carry a cell phone into the testing room. **Testing will begin promptly at the start times indicated, and no one will be allowed entrance after the test has begun.** If the Cobb County School District is closed on Friday, December 6th or December 13th for inclement weather, please check the magnet schools' websites for further information.
